(SENATORS ROSS, ANDERSON, BOLEY, BUCKALEW, GRUBB AND MACNAUGHTAN, original sponsors)

[Passed March 7, 1996; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact article eight, chapter sixtyfour of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine
hundred thirty-one, as amended, all relating generally
to the promulgation of administrative rules by the
various executive or administrative agencies and the
procedures relating thereto; legislative mandate or
authorization for the promulgation of certain legislative
rules by various executive and administrative agencies
of the state; authorizing certain of the agencies to
promulgate certain legislative rules in the form that the
rules were filed in the state register; authorizing certain
of the agencies to promulgate legislative rules as

amended by the Legislature; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate legislative rules with various modifications presented to and recommended by the legislative rule-making review committee; relating to authorizing the division of motor vehicles to promulgate legislative rules relating to the motor vehicle alcohol test and lock program, as modified; and relating to authorizing the division of motor vehicles to promulgate legislative rules relating to motor vehicle dealers, wrecker/dismantler/rebuilders, license services, automobile auctions, vehicle leasing companies and administrative due process, as modified.

## Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article eight, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

## ARTICLE 8. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.
