AN ACT to amend article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section sixteen, relating to requiring that certain buildings that are built with public funds and maintained with public funds shall have a sloped roof.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section sixteen, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 6. STATE BUILDING COMMISSION.**

**§5-6-16. Sloped roofs required.**

1     Notwithstanding any other provision of this code to the  
2     contrary, any building designed after the first day of  
3     April, one thousand nine hundred ninety-six, that is  
4     designed, constructed and maintained with public funds  
5     of the state, a county or a municipality the design of  
6     which includes a roof, then the roof shall have sufficient  
7     slope so that water will not accumulate into a pool on  
8     any area of the roof.






