[Passed March 5, 1996; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section fifteen, article thirty-one, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the West Virginia board of examiners in counseling until the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred ninety-seven.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fifteen, article thirty-one, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 31. LICENSED PROFESSIONAL COUNSELORS.

§30-31-15. Continuation of board.

- 1 After having conducted a preliminary performance
- 2 review through its joint committee on government
- 3 operations, pursuant to article ten, chapter four of this
- 4 code, the Legislature hereby finds and declares that the
- 5 West Virginia board of examiners in counseling should

6 be continued and reestablished. Accordingly, notwith-
7 standing the provisions of article ten, chapter four of this
8 code, the West Virginia board of examiners in counseling
9 shall continue to exist until the first day of July, one
10 thousand nine hundred ninety-seven, to allow for
11 monitoring of compliance with recommendations con-
12 tained in the preliminary performance review and to
13 allow for further review by the joint committee on
14 government operations.
