Senate Bill No. 362

(By Senators Tomblin, Mr. President, and Buckalew, By Request of the Executive)

[Passed March 12, 1998; to take effect July 1, 1998.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section five, article two, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to salaries of members of the West Virginia state police.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section five, article two, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WEST VIRGINIA STATE POLICE.

§15-2-5. Career progression system; salaries; exclusion from wage and hour law, with supplemental payment; bond; leave time for members called to duty in guard or reserves.

1 2 3 4 5 6 7 8 9 10 11	(a) The superintendent shall establish within the West Virginia state police a system to provide for: The promotion of members to the supervisory ranks of sergeant, first sergeant, second lieutenant and first lieutenant; the classification of nonsupervisory members within the field operations force to the ranks of trooper, senior trooper, trooper first class or corporal; the classification of members assigned to the forensic laboratory as criminalist I-VII; and the temporary reclassification of members assigned to administrative duties as administrative support specialist I-VIII.
12 13 14 15 16 17	(b) The superintendent is authorized to propose legislative rules for promulgation in accordance with article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code for the purpose of ensuring consistency, predictability and independent review of any system developed under the provisions of this section.
18 19 20 21 22 23 24	(c) The superintendent shall provide to each member a written manual governing any system established under the provisions of this section and specific procedures shall be identified for the evaluation and testing of members for promotion or reclassification and the subsequent placement of any members on a promotional eligibility or reclassification recommendation list.

- (e) Each member of the West Virginia state police whose 63 salary is fixed and specified pursuant to this section shall 64 receive and is entitled to an increase in salary over that set 65 forth in subsection (d) of this section, for grade in rank, 66 based on length of service, including that service served 67 before and after the effective date of this section with the 68 West Virginia state police as follows: At the end of five 69 years of service with the West Virginia state police, the 70 member shall receive a salary increase of three hundred 71 dollars to be effective during his or her next three years of 72 service and a like increase at three-year intervals thereaf-73 ter, with the increases to be cumulative. 74
 - (f) In applying the salary schedules set forth in this section where salary increases are provided for length of service, members of the West Virginia state police in service at the time the schedules become effective shall be given credit for prior service and shall be paid such salaries as the same length of service entitles them to receive under the provisions of this section.
 - (g) The Legislature finds and declares that because of 82 the unique duties of members of the West Virginia state 83 police, it is not appropriate to apply the provisions of state 84 wage and hour laws to them. Accordingly, members of the 85 West Virginia state police are excluded from the provi-86 sions of state wage and hour law. This express exclusion 87 shall not be construed as any indication that the members 88 were or were not covered by the wage and hour law prior 89 to this exclusion. 90
 - In lieu of any overtime pay they might otherwise have received under the wage and hour law, and in addition to their salaries and increases for length of service, members who have completed basic training and who are exempt from federal Fair Labor Standards Act guidelines may

96 receive supplemental pay as provided in this section.

The superintendent shall, within thirty days after the 97 effective date of this section, propose a legislative rule for 98 promulgation in accordance with article three, chapter 99 twenty-nine-a of this code, to establish the number of 100 hours per month which constitute the standard work 101 month for the members of the West Virginia state police. 102 The rule shall further establish, on a graduated hourly 103 basis, the criteria for receipt of a portion or all of supple-104 mental payment when hours are worked in excess of the 105 standard work month. The superintendent shall certify 106 107 monthly to the West Virginia state police's payroll officer the names of those members who have worked in excess of 108 the standard work month and the amount of their entitle-109 ment to supplemental payment. 110

- The supplemental payment may not exceed two hundred thirty-six dollars monthly. The superintendent and civilian employees of the West Virginia state police are not eligible for any supplemental payments.
- (h) Each member of the West Virginia state police, 115 except the superintendent and civilian employees, shall 116 execute, before entering upon the discharge of his or her 117 duties, a bond with security in the sum of five thousand 118 dollars payable to the state of West Virginia, conditioned 119 upon the faithful performance of his or her duties, and the 120 bond shall be approved as to form by the attorney general 121 122 and as to sufficiency by the governor.
- (i) Any member of the West Virginia state police who is 123 called to perform active duty for training or inactive duty 124 training in the national guard or any reserve component 125 of the armed forces of the United States annually shall be 126 granted, upon request, leave time not to exceed thirty 127 calendar days for the purpose of performing the active 128 duty for training or inactive duty training and the time 129 granted may not be deducted from any leave accumulated 130 as a member of the West Virginia state police. 131
