AN ACT supplementing, amending, reducing and increasing items of the existing appropriations from the state fund, general revenue, to the the bureau of commerce, West Virginia development office, fund 0256, fiscal year 1999, organization 0307, as originally appropriated by chapter six, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-eight, known as the "Budget Bill".
