AN ACT supplementing, amending, reducing and increasing items of the existing appropriations from the state fund, general revenue, to the the bureau of commerce, West Virginia development office, fund 0256, fiscal year 1999, organization 0307, as originally appropriated by chapter six, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-eight, known as the "Budget Bill".

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

1 That the items of the total appropriations from the state

4 organization 0307, be amended and reduced in the existing line

 35 Office of Coalfield Community Development (fund 0256,

38 The purpose of this supplementary appropriation bill is to
 39 supplement, amend, reduce and increase items of existing
 40 appropriations in the aforesaid account for the designated
 41 spending unit. The item for local economic development
 42 partnerships (R) (activity 133) is reduced by seventy-five

43 thousand dollars. The item for partnerships for industrial
44 modernization (R) (activity 592) is reduced by one hundred
45 twenty-five thousand dollars. The item for office of coalfield
46 community development (activity 326) is increased by one
47 hundred twenty-five thousand dollars. The amounts as itemized
48 for expenditure in the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of
49 June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-nine, shall be available
50 for expenditure immediately upon the effective date of this bill.


