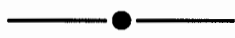

AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation in the state fund, general revenue, to the department of health and human resources — division of human services, fund 0403, fiscal year 2000, organization 0511, supplementing and amending the appropriation for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand, to fund 0403, fiscal year 2000, organization 0511, be supplemented and amended to read as follows:

44 Any unexpended balances remaining in the appropriations
 45 for Indigent Burials (fund 0403, activity 851) and West Virginia
 46 Childrens' Health Fund—Transfer (fund 0403, activity 714) at
 47 the close of fiscal year 1999 are hereby reappropriated for
 48 expenditure during fiscal year 2000.


49 The above appropriation for James "Tiger" Morton
 50 Catastrophic Illness Fund (activity 455) shall be transferred to
 51 the James "Tiger" Morton Catastrophic Illness Fund (fund
 52 5454) as provided by Chapter 16, Article 5Q, of the Code.

53 Notwithstanding the provisions of Title I, section three of
 54 this bill, the secretary of the department of health and human
 55 resources shall have the authority to transfer funds within the
 56 above account: *Provided*, That no more than ten percent of the
 57 funds appropriated to one line item may be transferred to other
 58 line items: *Provided, however*, That no funds from other line
 59 items shall be transferred to the personal services line item.


60 The secretary shall have authority to expend funds for the
 61 educational costs of those children residing in out-of-state
 62 placements, excluding the costs of special education programs.

63 The purpose of this bill is to supplement this account in the
 64 budget act for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June,
 65 two thousand, by amending language with no new money being
 66 appropriated.

That Joint Committee on Enrolled Bills hereby certifies that the foregoing bill is correctly enrolled.




