AN ACT to amend article five-a, chapter twenty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section four, relating to state employees continuing to accrue increment pay while off work because of a work-related injury; and legislative rules.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article five-a, chapter twenty-three of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section four, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5A. DISCRIMINATORY PRACTICES.

§23-5A-4. State employees to accrue increment pay during absence due to work-related injuries; legislative rules.

1 (a) All employees of the state of West Virginia shall
2 continue to accrue increment pay during absences from
3 work due to a work related compensable injury.

4 (b) The director of the division of personnel shall propose
5 rules for legislative approval to implement the provisions
6 of this section.
