AN ACT to amend article ten, chapter eighteen-b of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, relating to allowing members of the national guard participating in the national guard education services program who are not residents of West Virginia but who are active members of a national guard unit in this state to pay resident tuition rates at institutions of higher education.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article ten, chapter eighteen-b of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be

amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 10. FEES AND OTHER MONEY COLLECTED AT STATE INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

§18B-10-1a. Resident tuition rates for national guard members.

1 (a) The term "resident" or "residency", or any other term
2 or expression used to designate a West Virginia resident
3 student, when used to determine the rate of tuition to be
4 charged students attending community colleges and state-
5 related and state-owned institutions of higher education
6 shall be construed to include members of the national
7 guard who are not residents of West Virginia but who are
8 active members of a national guard unit in West Virginia
9 who are participating in the national guard education
10 services program.

11 (b) A member of the national guard who qualifies as a
12 resident, as that term is defined in subsection (a) of this
13 section, on the first day of the semester or term of the
14 college or institution, shall be charged resident tuition
15 rates.

16 (c) The provisions of this section apply at the beginning
17 of the semester or term immediately following the effective
18 date of this section.
