AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the state building commission.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. STATE BUILDING COMMISSION.

§5-6-1. Name of state office building commission changed; composition; appointment, terms and qualifications of members; chairman and secretary; compensation and expenses; powers and duties generally; frequency of meetings; continuation.

1 "The state office building commission of West Virginia",
2 hereto created, shall continue in existence, but on and
3 after the ninth day of February, one thousand nine hun-
4 dred sixty-six, shall be known and designated as "The
5 state building commission of West Virginia" and shall
6 continue as a body corporate and as an agency of the state
7 of West Virginia. On and after the date aforesaid, the
8 commission shall consist of the governor, attorney general,
9 state treasurer and four additional members to be ap-
10 pointed by the governor by and with the advice and
11 consent of the Senate. The terms of office for said mem-
12 bers to be appointed by the governor shall be four years,
13 except that the terms of office of the first four members so
14 appointed by the governor shall be for one, two, three and
15 four years, respectively. No more than three of such
16 members so appointed by the governor shall be members
17 of the same political party, nor shall any of said members
18 be members or employees of the executive, legislative or
19 judicial branches of government of West Virginia or any
20 political subdivision thereof. The governor shall be
21 chairman of the commission. The secretary of state shall
22 be a member of the commission and serve as its secretary,
23 but shall not have the right to vote upon matters before the
24 commission. All members of the commission shall be
25 citizens and residents of this state. The members of the
26 commission shall be paid or reimbursed for their necessary
27 expenses incurred under this article, but shall receive no
28 compensation for their services as members or officers of
29 the commission: *Provided*, That each member of the
30 commission appointed by the governor shall, in addition to
31 such reimbursement for necessary expenses, receive an
32 amount not to exceed the same compensation as is paid to
33 members of the Legislature for their interim duties as
34 recommended by the citizens legislative compensation
35 commission and authorized by law for each day or sub-
36 stantial portion thereof that he is engaged in the work of
37 the commission. Such expenses and per diem shall be paid
38 solely from funds provided under the authority of this
39 article, and the commission shall not proceed to exercise
40 or carry out any authority or power herein given it to bind
41 said commission beyond the extent to which money has
42 been provided under the authority of this article. On or

43 before the fifteenth day of each month, the commission
44 shall prepare and transmit to the president and minority
45 leader of the Senate and the speaker and the minority
46 leader of the House of Delegates a report covering the
47 activities of the said commission for the preceding calen-
48 dar month.

49 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
50 this code, the state building commission shall continue to
51 exist until the first day of July, two thousand.
