

## Senate Bill No. 488

(By Senators Love, Helmick, Sharpe, Edgell and Minear)

[Passed March 8, 1999; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT finding and declaring certain claims against the state and its agenies to be moral obligations of the state and directing the auditor to issue warrants for the payment thereof.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

CLAIMS AGAINST THE STATE.

§1. Finding and declaring certain claims against the department of education; division of corrections; and division of labor; to be moral obligations of the state and directing payments thereof.

1 The Legislature has heretofore made findings of fact that 2 the state has received the benefit of the commodities 3 received and/or services rendered by certain claimants 4 herein and has considered these claims against the state, 5 and agencies thereof, which have arisen due to 6 overexpenditures of the departmental appropriations by 7 officers of such state spending units, such claims having 8 been previously considered by the court of claims which

also found that the state has received the benefit of the 9 commodities received and/or services rendered by the 10 11 claimants, but were denied by the court of claims on the purely statutory grounds that to allow such claims would 12 13 be condoning illegal acts contrary to the laws of the state.
