AN ACT to amend article one-f, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section ten, relating to requiring compliance with the military selective service act.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article one-f, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section ten, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1F. PRIVILEGES AND PROHIBITIONS.

§15-1F-10. Selective service registration and compliance.

- 1 (a) A person may not enroll in a state-supported institu-
- 2 tion of postsecondary higher education unless he is in

3 compliance with the Military Selective Service Act, 50 U.
4 S. C. Appendix §451, et seq., and the amendments thereto.

5 (b) A person may not receive a loan, grant, scholarship or
6 other financial assistance for postsecondary higher
7 education funded by state revenue, including federal funds
8 or gifts and grants accepted by this state, or receive a
9 student loan guaranteed by the state unless he is in
10 compliance with the Military Selective Service Act.

11 (c) No male person who has attained the age of eighteen
12 years who fails to be in compliance with the Military
13 Selective Service Act is eligible for employment by or
14 service with the state or a political subdivision of the state,
15 including all boards, commissions, departments, agencies,
16 institutions and instrumentalities.

17 (d) It is the duty of all officials having charge of and
18 authority over the hiring of employees by the state or
19 political subdivisions, and over state-supported institu-
20 tions of postsecondary higher education, and over the
21 granting of state-supported financial assistance for
22 postsecondary higher education as described in this
23 section to assure themselves that applicants are in compli-
24 ance with the Military Selective Service Act.

25 (e) A person may not be denied a right, privilege or
26 benefit under this section by reason of failure to present
27 himself for and submit to the requirement to register
28 pursuant to the Military Selective Service Act if:

29 (1) The requirement for the person to so register has
30 terminated or become inapplicable to the person; and

31 (2) The person is or has already served in the armed
32 forces or has a condition that would preclude acceptability
33 for military service.






