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[Passed March 13, 1999; in effect ninety days from passage.]

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AN ACT to amend article five, chapter eighteen-b of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section two-d, relating to increasing level of state-funded per pupil support for certain community and technical colleges.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article five, chapter eighteen-b of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section two-d, to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 5. HIGHER EDUCATION BUDGETS AND EXPENDITURES.**

**§18B-5-2d. Community and technical college allocation.**

- 1 Each year the governing boards must request a special
- 2 appropriation from the Legislature to fund an additional

3 allocation to West Virginia Northern Community and  
4 Technical College, Southern West Virginia Community  
5 and Technical College, Potomac State College of West  
6 Virginia University and West Virginia University at  
7 Parkersburg, or any other community and technical  
8 college so designated in the appropriations bill. The total  
9 amount requested must equal any difference in per student  
10 appropriations existing between the public four-year  
11 baccalaureate institutions and the community and techni-  
12 cal colleges set out above, as calculated by the resource  
13 allocation model and resource allocation policies of the  
14 governing boards. Any appropriations received by the  
15 governing boards under this section must be allocated  
16 consistent with the appropriation request or must be  
17 reduced proportionally for each institution, if sufficient  
18 legislative appropriation is not made.
