### Senate Bill No. 684

(BY SENATORS CRAIGO, ANDERSON, BAILEY, BOWMAN, CHAFIN,  
EDGELL, HELMICK, JACKSON, LOVE, PLYMALE, PREZIOSO,  
SHARPE, UNGER, WALKER, SPROUSE, BOLEY AND MINEAR)

[Passed March 5, 1999; in effect from passage.]

AN ACT expiring funds to the unappropriated balance in the state fund, general revenue, for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand, in the amount of five hundred thousand dollars from the insurance commission - examination revolving fund, fund 7150, fiscal year 2000, organization 0704.

WHEREAS, The Legislature finds that the account balance in the insurance commission - examination revolving fund, fund 7150, fiscal year 2000, organization 0704, will exceed that which is necessary for the purposes for which the account was established; therefore

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

- 1 That the balance of funds available for expenditure in
- 2 the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two

3 thousand, to the insurance commission - examination  
4 revolving fund, fund 7150, fiscal year 2000, organization  
5 0704, be decreased by expiring the amount of five hundred  
6 thousand dollars to the unappropriated balance of the  
7 state fund, general revenue, to be available for appropria-  
8 tion during the fiscal year two thousand.

9 The purpose of this bill is to expire the sum of five  
10 hundred thousand dollars from the insurance commission -  
11 examination revolving fund, fund 7150, fiscal year 2000,  
12 organization 0704, to the unappropriated balance in the  
13 state fund, general revenue, for the fiscal year ending the  
14 thirtieth day of June, two thousand, to be available for  
15 appropriation during the fiscal year two thousand.
