AN ACT supplementing, amending and reducing, and increasing items of the existing appropriations from the state road fund to the department of transportation, division of highways, account no. fund 9017, fiscal year 1999, organization 0803, as originally appropriated by chapter six, acts of the Legislature, regular session, one thousand nine hundred ninety-eight, known as the budget bill.

WHEREAS, the governor submitted to the Legislature the executive budget document, dated January 13, 1999, which included the statement of the state road fund setting forth therein the cash balances and investments as of July 1, 1998, and further included the estimate of revenues for the fiscal year 1998-99, less net appropriation balances forwarded and regular appropriations for fiscal year 1998-99.

WHEREAS, it thus appears from the governor's executive budget document there now remains an unappropriated balance in the state treasury which is available for appropriation during the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one thousand nine hundred ninety-nine, therefore

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the items of the total appropriation from the state road fund to account 9017, fiscal year 1999, organization 0803, be amended and reduced in the line items as follows:

35 The purpose of this supplementary appropriation bill
36 is to supplement, amend, reduce and increase existing
37 items in the aforesaid account for the designated spending
38 unit. The item for Debt Service is reduced by two million
39 five hundred thousand dollars, ARC Assessment is reduced
40 by six hundred seven thousand dollars, and Appalachian
41 Programs is reduced by five million seven hundred fifty
42 thousand dollars. The item for Maintenance, State Local
43 Service is increased by ten million two hundred ninety-
44 nine thousand dollars, Maintenance, Contract Paving and
45 Secondary Road Maintenance is increased by four million
46 five hundred thousand dollars, Inventory Revolving is
47 increased by seven hundred fifty thousand dollars, Equip-
48 ment Revolving is increased by one million five hundred
49 thousand dollars, General Operations is increased by two
50 million seven hundred thousand dollars, Interstate Con-
51 struction is increased by four million dollars, Other
52 Federal Aid Programs is increased by forty-five million
53 two hundred fifty thousand dollars, and Nonfederal Aid
54 Construction is increased by three million five hundred
55 thousand dollars. The amounts as itemized for expendi-
56 ture in fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, one
57 thousand nine hundred ninety-nine shall be available for
58 expenditure immediately upon the effective date of this
59 bill.
