AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article two-b, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to authorizing the director to issue lifetime hunting, fishing and trapping licenses; providing that full-time nonresident students are ineligible for licenses; requiring director to promulgate legislative rules setting the fees; and authorizing the director to promulgate emergency rules.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seven, article two-b, chapter twenty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2B. WILDLIFE ENDOWMENT FUND.

§20-2B-7. Lifetime hunting, fishing and trapping licenses created.

1 (a) Pursuant to section three of this article, the director
2 may issue the following lifetime hunting, fishing and
3 trapping licenses and for the lifetime of the licensee, the
4 lifetime licenses serve in lieu of the equivalent annual
5 license: lifetime resident statewide hunting and trapping
6 license; lifetime resident combination statewide hunting,
7 fishing and trapping license; lifetime statewide fishing
8 license; and lifetime resident trout fishing license: *Pro-*
9 *vided*, That a full-time nonresident student who attends an
10 in-state college or university is not eligible to purchase any
11 of these lifetime licenses.

12 (b) The director shall propose a legislative rule for
13 promulgation in accordance with article three, chapter
14 twenty-nine-a of this code, setting the fees for the lifetime
15 licenses. The rule shall provide that the fee for any
16 resident who has not reached his or her second birthday
17 shall be one half of the adult fee set under the rule:
18 *Provided*, That the rule first proposed for promulgation
19 under this section may be promulgated as an emergency
20 rule under the provisions of section fifteen, article three,
21 chapter twenty-nine of this code.
