AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article twenty-six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, related to continuing the Governor's cabinet on children and families.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eight, article twenty-six, chapter five of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 26. GOVERNOR'S CABINET ON CHILDREN AND FAMILIES.

§5-26-8. Termination date.

- 1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
- 2 this code, the governor's cabinet on children and families
- 3 shall continue to exist until the first day of July, two
- 4 thousand five: *Provided*, That the cabinet shall prepare an

- 5 annual progress report and shall present the report to the
- 6 joint committee on government operations. The report
- 7 shall detail the cabinet's compliance with its purposes,
- 8 duties and responsibilities as set forth in sections one,
- 9 three and four of this article, together with proposed plans
- 10 for future compliance and proposed programs for the
- 11 following year.
