AN ACT to amend and reenact section eighteen, article three, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuing the board of medicine.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section eighteen, article three, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. WEST VIRGINIA MEDICAL PRACTICE ACT.

§30-3-18. Continuation of board.

1 The board of medicine shall continue to exist until the
2 first day of July, two thousand one, pursuant to the
3 provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code, to allow

4 for the completion of a regulatory board review by the
5 joint committee on government operations.
