AN ACT to amend article six-g, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto two new sections, designated sections three-a and three-b, all relating to paying ad valorem taxes on commercial motor vehicles registered for a proportion of an entire year; ad valorem taxes on transferred vehicles; and the apportionment of the fees.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That article six-g, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto two new sections, designated sections three-a and three-b, all to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 6G. ASSESSMENT OF INTERSTATE PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATION MOTOR VEHICLE BUSINESS REGISTERED UNDER A PROPORTIONAL REGISTRATION AGREEMENT.**

**§11-6G-3a. Reduced fees for portion of year.**

1 The ad valorem fees prescribed in section three of this  
2 article are for the entire fiscal year: *Provided*, That when  
3 application for a proportional registration is made be-  
4 tween the first day of August and the thirty-first day of  
5 August, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee for registra-  
6 tion is eleven-twelfths of the yearly fee; when application  
7 for the registration is made between the first day of  
8 September and the thirtieth day of September, inclusive,  
9 in any fiscal year, the fee for registration is ten-twelfths of  
10 the yearly fee; when application for the registration is  
11 made between the first day of October and the thirty-first  
12 day of October, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee for  
13 registration is nine-twelfths of the yearly fee; when  
14 application for the registration is made between the first  
15 day of November and the thirtieth day of November,  
16 inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee for registration is  
17 eight-twelfths of the yearly fee; when application for  
18 registration is made between the first day of December  
19 and the thirty-first day of December, inclusive, in any  
20 fiscal year, the fee for registration is seven-twelfths of the  
21 yearly fee; when application for registration is made  
22 between the first day of January and the thirty-first day of  
23 January, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee for registra-  
24 tion is one-half of the yearly fee; when application for  
25 registration is made between the first day of February and  
26 the last day of February, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the  
27 fee for registration is five-twelfths of the yearly fee; when  
28 application for registration is made between the first day  
29 of March and the thirty-first day of March, inclusive, in  
30 any fiscal year, the fee for registration is one-third of the  
31 yearly fee; when application for registration is made

32 between the first day of April and the thirtieth day of  
33 April, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee for registration  
34 is one-fourth of the yearly fee; when application for  
35 registration is made between the first day of May and the  
36 thirty-first day of May, inclusive, in any fiscal year, the fee  
37 for registration is two-twelfths of the yearly fee; and when  
38 application for registration is made between the first day  
39 of June and the thirtieth day of June, inclusive, in any  
40 fiscal year, the fee for registration is one-twelfth of the  
41 yearly fee.

**§11-6G-3b. Reduced fees for transfer of vehicles.**

1 The ad valorem fees prescribed in sections three and  
2 three-a of this article shall be reduced in the amount of ad  
3 valorem fees paid on the original vehicle upon the transfer  
4 of registration by an owner from the original vehicle to  
5 another vehicle of the same class. The reduction in the  
6 amount of ad valorem fees paid on the original vehicle  
7 shall be prorated monthly up to the amount of ad valorem  
8 fees owed on the vehicle to which registration is being  
9 transferred. Any remainder of ad valorem fees paid on the  
10 original vehicle shall be reviewed by the interstate appeals  
11 board, created in section seven of this article.
