AN ACT to amend and reenact section three, article one, chapter twenty-four-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to exempting from the chapter those motor vehicles designated by the bureau of senior services for use by local county aging programs; and providing that those motor vehicles and the operators follow commission safety rules.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section three, article one, chapter twenty-four-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. PURPOSES, DEFINITIONS AND EXEMPTIONS.

§24A-1-3. Exemptions from chapter.

- 1 The provisions of this chapter, except where specifically
- 2 otherwise provided, do not apply to:
- 3 (1) Motor vehicles operated exclusively in the transpor-
- 4 tation of United States mail or in the transportation of
- 5 newspapers: *Provided*, That the vehicles and their opera-
- 6 tors shall be subject to the safety rules promulgated by the
- 7 commission;
- 8 (2) Motor vehicles owned and operated by the United
- 9 States of America, the state of West Virginia or any
- 10 county, municipality or county board of education, urban
- 11 mass transportation authority established and maintained
- 12 pursuant to article twenty-seven, chapter eight of this
- 13 code, or by any department thereof, and any motor
- 14 vehicles operated under a contract with a county board of
- 15 education exclusively for the transportation of children to
- 16 and from school or other legitimate transportation for the
- 17 schools as the commission may specifically authorize;
- 18 (3) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation
- 19 of agricultural or horticultural products, livestock, poultry
- 20 and dairy products from the farm or orchard on which
- 21 they are raised or produced to markets, processing plants,
- 22 packing houses, canneries, railway shipping points and
- 23 cold storage plants, and in the transportation of agricul-
- 24 tural or horticultural supplies to farms or orchards to be
- 25 used thereon;
- 26 (4) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation
- 27 of human or animal excreta;
- 28 (5) Motor vehicles used exclusively in ambulance service
- 29 or duly chartered rescue squad service;
- 30 (6) Motor vehicles used exclusively for volunteer fire
- 31 department service;

- 32 (7) Motor vehicles used exclusively in the transportation
- 33 of coal from mining operations to loading facilities for
- 34 further shipment by rail or water carriers: Provided, That
- 35 the vehicles and their operators shall be subject to the
- 36 safety rules promulgated by the commission;
- 37 (8) Motor vehicles used by petroleum commission agents
- 38 and oil distributors solely for the transportation of petro-
- 39 leum products and related automotive products when the
- 40 transportation is incidental to the business of selling the
- 41 products: *Provided*, That the vehicles and their operators
- 42 shall be subject to the safety rules promulgated by the
- 43 commission:
- 44 (9) Motor vehicles owned, leased by or leased to any
- 45 person and used exclusively for the transportation of
- 46 processed source-separated recycled materials, generated
- 47 by commercial, institutional and industrial customers,
- 48 transported free of charge from the customers to a facility
- 49 for further processing: Provided, That the vehicles and
- 50 their operators shall be subject to the safety rules promul-
- 51 gated by the commission;
- 52 (10) Motor vehicles specifically preempted from state
- 53 economic regulation of intrastate motor carrier operations
- 54 by the provisions of the federal aviation administration
- 55 authorization act of 1994 (Pub. L. 103-305 §601 108 Stat.
- 56 1605 (1994)): *Provided*, That the vehicles and their opera-
- 57 tors shall be subject to the safety rules promulgated by the
- 58 commission; and
- 59 (11) Motor vehicles designated by the West Virginia
- 60 bureau of senior services for use and operation by local
- 61 county aging programs: Provided, That the vehicles and
- 62 their operators shall be subject to the safety rules promul-
- 63 gated by the commission.
