Senate Bill No. 582

(BY SENATOR HUNTER)

[Passed March 11, 2000; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, relating to permitting certain officers and state employees to waive their salaries; setting forth methodology of waiver; and other provisions as to waiver of salary.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article seven, chapter six of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated section one-a, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 7. COMPENSATION AND ALLOWANCES.

§6-7-1a. Waiver of salary by elected or appointed state officials, officers and employees.


1 (a) Any full-time or part-time salaried or hourly official,
2 officer or employee of the state may waive all or part of
3 the compensation for that person's office or position. The
4 waiver shall be in writing and signed by the person
5 waiving the salary or wages, notarized and filed with the
6 secretary of state.

7 (b) A waiver of compensation may be revoked in writing
8 and signed by the person who filed the waiver, notarized
9 and filed with the secretary of state.

10 (c) If an elected public official desires to waive the salary
11 of the elected office, the waiver may be made only after
12 the person has been elected to office and the results of the
13 election have been certified by the secretary of state:
14 *Provided*, That the waiver must be made prior to taking
15 the oath of office.

16 (d) Persons who waive the salary or wage shall be
17 covered by workers' compensation pursuant to the provi-
18 sions of chapter twenty-three of this code: *Provided*, That
19 such persons shall waive coverage in the public employees
20 retirement system or the teachers retirement system.


