AN ACT to repeal section sixteen, article fourteen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended; and to amend and reenact section three of said article, relating to extending the termination date of the extra five cents a gallon gas tax; requiring annual report to the Legislature; and providing for confidentiality.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section sixteen, article fourteen, chapter eleven of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be repealed; and that section three of said article be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 14. GASOLINE AND SPECIAL FUEL EXCISE TAX.

§11-14-3. Imposition of tax.

Provided, That beginning the first day of May, one thou-

sand nine hundred ninety-three, the tax levied by this

7 article shall be twenty and one-half cents per gallon:

Provided, however. That on and after the first day of 8

August, two thousand seven, the tax levied by this article 9

10 shall be fifteen and one-half cents per gallon.

Beginning on the fifteenth day of January, two thousand 11 three, and every fifteenth day of January thereafter, the 12 13 tax commissioner shall submit to the Legislature an annual report identifying the amount of revenue collected 14 15 from the imposition of the tax imposed by this section in each county of this state via sales at each individual retail 16 gas pump during the preceding fiscal year. Notwithstand-17 ing any provision of this code to the contrary, all informa-18 19 tion individually made available to the tax commissioner by a taxpayer that is utilized in the preparation of the 20 report to the Legislature required by this section is 21 22 confidential and may not be disclosed to any person in any 23 manner inconsistent with any law of this state protecting 24 the confidentiality of taxpayer returns filed pursuant to this article. 25
