AN ACT to amend and reenact section one, article one, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended; and to amend and reenact article two of said chapter, all relating generally to the promulgation of administrative rules by the various executive or administrative agencies and the procedures relating thereto; continuing rules previously promulgated by state agencies and boards; clarifying legislative intent relating to promulgation or legislative rules; modifying method of disapproval of certain legislative rules; legislative mandate or authorization for the promulgation of certain legislative rules; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules in the form that the rules were filed

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section one, article one, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted; and that article two of said chapter be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1. GENERAL LEGISLATIVE AUTHORIZATION.

§64-1-1. Legislative authorization.

Under the provisions of article three, chapter 1 twenty-nine-a of the code of West Virginia, the Legislature 2 expressly authorizes the promulgation of the rules de-3 scribed in articles two through eleven, inclusive, of this 4 chapter, subject only to the limitations set forth with 5 respect to each such rule in the section or sections of this 6 chapter authorizing its promulgation. Legislative rules 7 promulgated pursuant to the provisions of articles one 8 through eleven, inclusive, of this chapter in effect at the 9 effective date of this section shall continue in full force 10 and effect until reauthorized in this chapter by legislative 11 enactment or until amended by emergency rule pursuant 12 to the provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of 13 this code. 14

ARTICLE 2. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-2-1. Department of administration and the auditor.
