AN ACT to amend and reenact section four hundred two, article two, chapter forty-eight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to persons authorized to celebrate marriages; requiring the secretary of state to authorize certain persons to celebrate marriages; establishing a statewide registry for persons authorized to celebrate marriages; permitting a registration fee; requiring county clerks to transmit names of persons authorized to celebrate marriages to secretary of state; and creating registration fee fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four hundred two, article two, chapter fortyeight of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. MARRIAGES.

- §48-2-402. Qualifications of religious representative for celebrating marriages; registry of persons authorized to perform marriage ceremonies; special revenue fund.
 - 1 (a) Beginning the first day of September, two thousand
 - 2 one, the secretary of state shall, upon payment of the
 - registration fee established by the secretary of state
 - 4 pursuant to subsection (d) of this section, make an order
 - 5 authorizing a person who is a religious representative to
 - 6 celebrate the rites of marriage in all the counties of the
 - 7 state, upon proof that the person:
 - 8 (1) Is eighteen years of age or older;
 - 9 (2) Is duly authorized to perform marriages by his or her
 - 10 church, synagogue, spiritual assembly or religious organi-
 - 11 zation: and
 - 12 (3) Is in regular communion with the church, synagogue,
 - 13 spiritual assembly or religious organization of which he or
 - 14 she is a member.
 - 15 (b) The person shall give bond in the penalty of one
 - 16 thousand five hundred dollars, with surety approved by
 - 17 the commission. Any religious representative who gives
 - 18 proof before the county commission of his or her ordina-
 - 19 tion or authorization by his or her respective church,
 - 20 synagogue, spiritual assembly or religious organization is
 - 21 exempt from giving the bond.
 - 22 (c) The secretary of state shall establish a central
 - 23 registry of persons authorized to celebrate marriages in
 - 24 this state. Every person authorized under the provisions
 - 25 of subsection (a) of this section to celebrate marriages shall
 - 26 be listed in this registry. Every county clerk shall, prior to
 - 27 the first day of October, two thousand one, transmit to the

- 28 secretary of state the name of every person authorized to
- 29 celebrate marriages by order issued in his or her county
- 30 since one thousand nine hundred sixty and the secretary of
- 31 state shall include these names in the registry. The
- 32 completed registry and periodic updates shall be transmit-
- 33 ted to every county clerk.
- 34 (d) A fee not to exceed twenty-five dollars may be
- 35 charged by the secretary of state for each registration
- 36 received on or after the first day of September, two
- 37 thousand one, and all money received shall be deposited in
- 38 a special revenue revolving fund designated the "Marriage
- 39 Celebrants Registration Fee Administration Fund" in the
- 40 state treasury to be administered by the secretary of state.
- 41 Expenses incurred by the secretary in the implementation
- 42 and operation of the registry program shall be paid from
- 43 the fund.
- 44 (e) No marriage performed by a person authorized by
- 45 law to celebrate marriages may be invalidated solely
- 46 because the person was not listed in the registry provided
- 47 for in this section.
- 48 (f) The secretary of state shall promulgate rules to
- 49 implement the provisions of this section.
