AN ACT to amend and reenact section four, article thirteen-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to authorizing the board of examiners of land surveyors to promulgate emergency and legislative rules.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section four, article thirteen-a, chapter thirty of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 13A. LAND SURVEYORS.

§30-13A-4. Powers and duties of board; funds.

- 1 (a) The board shall have the power and duty to:
- 2 (1) Examine applicants and determine their eligibility
- 3 for a license to engage in the practice of land surveying;

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(2) Prepare, conduct and grade an apt and proper 5 written, oral or written and oral examination of applicants AIMIOSIV 6 for a license and determine the satisfactory passing score 7 thereon;

> 8 (3) Promulgate reasonable rules implementing the 9 provisions of this article and the powers and duties 10 conferred upon the board hereby, all of which reasonable 11 rules shall be promulgated in accordance with the provi-12 sions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code;

> (4) Issue, renew, deny, suspend or revoke licenses to
> engage in the practice of land surveying in accordance
> with the provisions of this article;

16 (5) Investigate alleged violations of the provisions of this article, reasonable rules promulgated hereunder and 17 18 orders and final decisions of the board and take appropriate disciplinary action against any licensee for the viola-19 tion thereof or institute appropriate legal action for the 2021enforcement of the provisions of this article, reasonable 22 rules promulgated hereunder and orders and final deci-23sions of the board or take such disciplinary action and $\mathbf{24}$ institute such legal action;

(6) Keep accurate and complete records of its proceedings, certify the same as may be appropriate and prepare,
from time to time, a list showing the names and addresses
of all licensees;

(7) Take such other action as may be reasonably neces-sary or appropriate to effectuate the provisions of thisarticle; and

(8) Establish standards to evaluate surveying curricula
as it relates to the practice of land surveying under the
provisions of this article and to determine the amount of
experience required under section five of this article which
may be substituted for a particular curriculum.

(b) All moneys paid to the board shall be accepted by a 37 person designated by the board and deposited by him with 38 the treasurer of the state and credited to an account to be 39 known as the "board of examiners of land surveyors 40 fund". All of the reasonable compensation of the members 41 of the board, the reimbursement of all reasonable and 42 necessary expenses actually incurred by such members and 43 all other costs and expenses incurred by the board in the 44 administration of this article shall be paid from such fund, 45 46 and no part of the state's general revenue fund shall be expended for this purpose. 47

(9) The Legislature finds that an emergency situation
exists and, therefore, the board is hereby authorized to
establish by emergency rule, pursuant to the provisions of
article three-a, chapter twenty-nine-a of this code, a rule
to effectuate the purpose of this article, including, but not
limited to, continuing education.
