ARTICLE 2. DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLES.

§17A-2-24. Termination of department.

- 1 The department of motor vehicles shall terminate on the
- 2 first day of July, two thousand three, pursuant to the

3 provisions of article ten, chapter four of this code unless
4 sooner terminated, continued or reestablished pursuant to
5 the provisions of that article.
