AN ACT making a supplementary appropriation from the balance of moneys remaining unappropriated for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand two, to the department of tax and revenue—tax division—special audit and investigative unit, fund 7073, fiscal year 2002, organization 0702, all supplementing and amending the appropriation for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand two.


WHEREAS, The governor has established that there now remains an unappropriated balance in the department of tax and revenue—tax division—special audit and investigative unit, fund 7073, fiscal year 2002, organization 0702, available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand two; therefore

That the total appropriation for the fiscal year ending the thirtieth day of June, two thousand two, to fund 7073, fiscal year 2002, organization 0702, be supplemented and amended by increasing the








