

## Senate Bill No. 543

(SENATORS FACEMYER, CALDWELL, MINEAR, ROWE, SNYDER AND ROSS, original sponsors)

[Passed March 9, 2002; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section fourteen, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to motor vehicle registration and authorizing specialized motor vehicle registration plates; deleting the provision that division may not issue more than two Class A and two Class G special registration plates for certain officials; adding West Virginia circuit court judges, active and retired, as officials eligible for special registration plates; license plates for war veterans; reducing the registration fee for certain veterans; including bronze star recipients as veterans eligible for a special plates; authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates for certified CINE (FI)

firefighters; providing for the issuance of special plates for all honorably discharged veterans; providing for a one-time fee of ten dollars for disabled veterans, former prisoners of war, Pearl Harbor survivors, purple heart recipients and recipients of the congressional medal of honor; authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates for volunteer firemen and women; authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates displaying patriotic themes; authorizing special registration plates showing the American flag bearing the logo "9/11/01"; authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates celebrating the centennial of the 4-H youth development movement; authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates for the future farmers of America organization; and authorizing the division of motor vehicles to issue special registration plates for educators.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section fourteen, article three, chapter seventeen-a of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. ORIGINAL AND RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATES OF TITLE.

§17A-3-14. Registration plates generally; description of plates; issuance of special numbers and plates; registration fees; special application fees; exemptions; commissioner to promulgate forms; suspension and nonrenewal.

(a) The division upon registering a vehicle shall issue to
 the owner one registration plate for a motorcycle, trailer,
 semitrailer or other motor vehicle.

4 (b) Registration plates issued by the division shall meet5 the following requirements:

6 (1) Every registration plate shall be of reflectorized7 material and have displayed upon it the registration

8 number assigned to the vehicle for which it is issued; the
9 name of this state, which may be abbreviated; and the year
10 number for which it is issued or the date of expiration of
11 the plate.

12 (2) Every registration plate and the required letters and 13 numerals on the plate shall be of sufficient size to be 14 plainly readable from a distance of one hundred feet 15 during daylight: *Provided*, That the requirements of this 16 subdivision shall not apply to the year number for which 17 the plate is issued or the date of expiration.

18 (3) Registration numbering for registration plates shall19 begin with number two.

20 (c) The division may not issue, permit to be issued or21 distribute any special registration plates except as follows:

(1) The governor shall be issued two registration plates,
on one of which shall be imprinted the numeral one and on
the other the word one.

(2) State officials and judges may be issued specialregistration plates as follows:

27 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to the secretary of state, state superintendent of 28 schools, auditor, treasurer, commissioner of agriculture 29 and the attorney general, the members of both houses of 30 the Legislature, including the elected officials of both 31 32 houses of the Legislature, the justices of the supreme court of appeals of West Virginia, the representatives and 33 senators of the state in the Congress of the United States, 34 the judges of the West Virginia circuit courts, active and 35 retired on senior status, the judges of the United States 36 district courts for the state of West Virginia and the judges 37 38 of the United States court of appeals for the fourth circuit, if any of the judges are residents of West Virginia, a 39 special registration plate for a Class A motor vehicle and 40 a special registration plate for a Class G motorcycle owned 41 42 by the official or his or her spouse: Provided, That the

division may issue a Class A special registration plate for
each vehicle titled to the official and a Class G special
registration plate for each motorcycle titled to the official.

(B) Each plate issued pursuant to this subdivision shall
bear any combination of letters and numbers not to exceed
an amount determined by the commissioner and a designation of the office. Each plate shall supersede the regular
numbered plate assigned to the official or his or her spouse
during the official's term of office and while the motor
vehicle is owned by the official or his or her spouse.

(C) The division shall charge an annual fee of fifteen
dollars for every registration plate issued pursuant to this
subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required
by this chapter.

57 (3) The division may issue members of the national guard58 forces special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon receipt of an application on a form prescribed 59 by the division and receipt of written evidence from the 60 61 chief executive officer of the army national guard or air 62 national guard, as appropriate, or the commanding officer 63 of any United States armed forces reserve unit that the 64 applicant is a member thereof, the division shall issue to 65 any member of the national guard of this state or a member of any reserve unit of the United States armed 66 67 forces a special registration plate designed by the commis-68 sioner for any number of Class A motor vehicles owned by the member. Upon presentation of written evidence of 69 70 retirement status, retired members of this state's army or 71 air national guard, or retired members of any reserve unit of the United States armed forces, are eligible to purchase 72 73 the special registration plate issued pursuant to this 74 subdivision.

(B) The division shall charge an initial application fee of
ten dollars for each special registration plate issued
pursuant to this subdivision, which is in addition to all

other fees required by this chapter. All initial application
fees collected by the division shall be deposited into a
special revolving fund to be used in the administration of
this section.

82 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
83 deceased spouse's national guard forces license plate until
84 the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
85 license plate.

86 (4) Specially arranged registration plates may be issued87 as follows:

88 (A) Upon appropriate application, any owner of a motor 89 vehicle subject to Class A registration, or a motorcycle 90 subject to Class G registration, as defined by this article, 91 may request that the division issue a registration plate 92 bearing specially arranged letters or numbers with the 93 maximum number of letters or numbers to be determined by the commissioner. The division shall attempt to comply 94 95 with the request wherever possible.

96 (B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
97 approval in accordance with the provisions of chapter
98 twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the orderly distribu99 tion of the plates: *Provided*, That for purposes of this
100 subdivision, the registration plates requested and issued
101 shall include all plates bearing the numbers two through
102 two thousand.

103 (C) An annual fee of fifteen dollars shall be charged for
104 each special registration plate issued pursuant to this
105 subdivision, which is in addition to all other fees required
106 by this chapter.

107 (5) The division may issue honorably discharged veterans108 special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shallissue to any honorably discharged veteran of any branchof the armed services of the United States a special

registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the 112 name of the qualified applicant with an insignia designed

113 by the commissioner of the division of motor vehicles.

114

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application 115 116 fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee is to compensate the division of 117 118 motor vehicles for additional costs and services required in the issuing of the special registration and shall be 119 collected by the division and deposited in a special revolv-120 ing fund to be used for the administration of this section: 121 Provided, That nothing in this section may be construed to 122 exempt any veteran from any other provision of this 123 124 chapter.

125 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her 126 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license 127 plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not 128 renew the license plate.

(6) The division may issue disabled veterans special 129 130 registration plates as follows:

131 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall issue to any disabled veteran who is exempt from the 132 payment of registration fees under the provisions of this 133 chapter a registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name 134 of the qualified applicant which bears the letters "DV" in 135 136 red and also the regular identification numerals in red.

137 (B) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her deceased spouse's disabled veterans license plate until the 138 surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the 139 140 license plate.

141 (C) A qualified disabled veteran may obtain a second disabled veteran license plate as described in this section 142 143 for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the 144 qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of ten dollars to be deposited into a special revolving 145 146 fund to be used in the administration of this section, in

addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for thesecond plate.

(7) The division may issue recipients of the distinguishedpurple heart medal special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued 151 152to any armed service person holding the distinguished 153 purple heart medal for persons wounded in combat a 154 registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant bearing letters or numbers. 155 The 156 registration plate shall be designed by the commissioner of motor vehicles and shall denote that those individuals who 157 158 are granted this special registration plate are recipients of 159 the purple heart. All letterings shall be in purple where 160 practical.

(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision are exempt from all registration fees otherwise
required by the provisions of this chapter.

164 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
165 deceased spouse's purple heart medal license plate until
166 the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the
167 license plate.

168 (D) A recipient of the purple heart medal may obtain a second purple heart medal license plate as described in 169 this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the 170 name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge 171 a one-time fee of ten dollars to be deposited into a special 172 revolving fund to be used in the administration of this 173 section, in addition to all other fees required by this 174 chapter, for the second plate. 175

(8) The division may issue survivors of the attack onPearl Harbor special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the owner of a motor
vehicle who was enlisted in any branch of the armed
services that participated in and survived the attack on

181 Pearl Harbor on the seventh day of December, one thou182 sand nine hundred forty-one, the division shall issue a
183 special registration plate for a vehicle titled in the name of
184 the qualified applicant. The registration plate shall be
185 designed by the commissioner of motor vehicles.

(B) Registration plates issued pursuant to this subdivision are exempt from the payment of all registration fees
otherwise required by the provisions of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor
license plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or
does not renew the license plate.

(D) A survivor of the attack on Pearl Harbor may obtain a second survivors of the attack on Pearl Harbor license plate as described in this section for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant. The division shall charge a one-time fee of ten dollars to be deposited into a special revolving fund to be used in the administration of this section, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter, for the second plate.

(9) The division may issue special registration plates to
 nonprofit charitable and educational organizations as
 follows:

(A) Approved nonprofit charitable and educational 204 organizations may accept and collect applications for 205 special registration plates from owners of Class A motor 206 207 vehicles together with a special annual fee of fifteen dollars, which is in addition to all other fees required by 208 this chapter. The applications and fees shall be submitted 209 to the division of motor vehicles with the request that the 210  $division\, issue a\, registration\, plate bearing\, a\, combination\, of$ 211 212 letters or numbers with the organizations' logo or emblem, with the maximum number of letters or numbers to be 213 214 determined by the commissioner.

(B) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,
chapter twenty-nine-a of this code regarding the procedures for and approval of special registration plates issued
pursuant to this subdivision.

220 (C) The commissioner shall set an appropriate fee to 221defray the administrative costs associated with designing 222 and manufacturing special registration plates for a 223 nonprofit charitable or educational organization. The 224 nonprofit charitable or educational organization shall 225 collect this fee and forward it to the division for deposit in 226 a special revolving fund to pay the administrative costs. 227 The nonprofit charitable or educational organization may also collect a fee for marketing the special registration 228 229 plates.

(10) The division may issue specified emergency orvolunteer registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the 232 state of West Virginia and who is a certified paramedic or 233 emergency medical technician, a member of a paid fire 234 department, a member of the state fire commission, the 235 state fire marshal, the state fire marshal's assistants, the 236 state fire administrator and voluntary rescue squad 237 members may apply for a special license plate for any 238 number of Class A vehicles titled in the name of the 239 qualified applicant which bears the insignia of the profes-240 sion, group or commission. Any insignia shall be designed 241 by the commissioner. License plates issued pursuant to 242 this subdivision shall bear the requested insignia in 243 addition to the registration number issued to the applicant 244 pursuant to the provisions of this article. 245

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the
fire chief or department head of the applicant stating that
the applicant is justified in having a registration with the
requested insignia; proof of compliance with all laws of

this state regarding registration and licensure of motorvehicles; and payment of all required fees.

(C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special initial 253 application fee of ten dollars, which is in addition to any 254 other registration or license fee required by this chapter. 255 256 All special fees shall be collected by the division and 257 deposited into a special revolving fund to be used for the 258 purpose of compensating the division of motor vehicles for 259 additional costs and services required in the issuing of the 260 special registration and for the administration of this 261 section. 262

263 (11) The division may issue specified certified firefighter264 registration plates as follows:

(A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of the 265 state of West Virginia and who is a certified firefighter 266 may apply for a special license plate which bears the 267 insignia of the profession, for any number of Class A 268 vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant. Any 269 insignia shall be designed by the commissioner. License 270 271 plates issued pursuant to this subdivision shall bear the 272 requested insignia pursuant to the provisions of this 273 article. Upon presentation of written evidence of certifica-274 tion as a certified firefighter, certified firefighters are 275 eligible to purchase the special registration plate, issued 276 pursuant to this subdivision.

277 (B) Each year an application submitted pursuant to this 278 subdivisionshall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by 279 the West Virginia state fire commission or a copy of the 280 applicant's certification as a certified firefighter, with certification number, stating that the applicant is justified 281 in having a registration with the requested insignia; proof 282 283 of compliance with all laws of this state regarding regis-284 tration and licensure of motor vehicles; and payment of all 285 required fees.

286 (C) Each year an application submitted pursuant to this 287 subdivision shall be accompanied by payment of a special 288 initial application fee of ten dollars, which is in addition 289 to any other registration or license fee required by this chapter. All special fees shall be collected by the division 290 291 and deposited into a special revolving fund to be used for 292 the purpose of compensating the division of motor vehicles for additional costs and services required in the issuing of 293 the special registration and for the administration of this 294 295 section.

296 (12) The division may issue special scenic registration
297 plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner
shall issue a special registration plate displaying a scenic
design of West Virginia which displays the words "Wild
Wonderful" as a slogan.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
application fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees
required by this chapter. All initial application fees
collected by the division shall be deposited into a special
revolving fund to be used in the administration of this
chapter.

308 (13) The division may issue honorably discharged marine
 309 corps league members special registration plates as
 310 follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall
issue to any honorably discharged marine corps league
member a special registration plate for any number of
vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant with
an insignia designed by the commissioner of the division
of motor vehicles.

(B) The division may charge a special one-time initial
application fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees
required by this chapter. This special fee is to compensate
the division of motor vehicles for additional costs and

services required in the issuing of the special registration
and shall be collected by the division and deposited in a
special revolving fund to be used for the administration of
this section: *Provided*, That nothing in this section may be
construed to exempt any veteran from any other provision
of this chapter.

327 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
328 deceased spouse's honorably discharged marine corps
329 league license plate until the surviving spouse dies,
330 remarries or does not renew the license plate.

(14) The division may issue military organizationregistration plates as follows:

(A) The division may issue a special registration plate for
the members of any military organization chartered by the
United States congress upon receipt of a guarantee from
organization of a minimum of one hundred applicants.
The insignia on the plate shall be designed by the commissioner.

(B) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
members of the chartered organization in good standing,
as determined by the governing body of the chartered
organization, a special registration plate for any number
of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant.

344 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 345 application fee of ten dollars for each special license plate 346 in addition to all other fees required by this chapter. All 347 initial application fees collected by the division shall be 348 deposited into a special revolving fund to be used in the 349 administration of this chapter: Provided, That nothing in 350 this section may be construed to exempt any veteran from 351 any other provision of this chapter.

(D) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's military organization registration plate
until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
renew the special military organization registration plate.

(15) The division may issue special nongame wildlife
registration plates and special wildlife registration plates
as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall
issue a special registration plate displaying a species of
West Virginia wildlife which shall display a species of
wildlife native to West Virginia as prescribed and designated by the commissioner and the director of the division
of natural resources.

365 (B) The division shall charge an annual fee of fifteen 366 dollars for each special nongame wildlife registration plate and each special wildlife registration plate in addition to 367 368 all other fees required by this chapter. All annual fees collected for nongame wildlife registration plates and 369 370 wildlife registration plates shall be deposited in a special 371 revenue account designated the nongame wildlife fund and 372 credited to the division of natural resources.

373 (C) The division shall charge a special one-time initial
374 application fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees
375 required by this chapter. All initial application fees
376 collected by the division shall be deposited in a special
377 revolving fund to be used in the administration of this
378 chapter.

(16) The division may issue members of the silver hairedlegislature special registration plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall
issue to any person who is a duly qualified member of the
silver haired legislature a specialized registration plate
which bears recognition of the applicant as a member of
the silver haired legislature.

(B) A qualified member of the silver haired legislature
may obtain one registration plate described in this subdivision for use on a passenger vehicle titled in the name of
the qualified applicant. The division shall charge an
annual fee of fifteen dollars, in addition to all other fees

required by this chapter, for the plate. All annual fees
collected by the division shall be deposited in a special
revolving fund to be used in the administration of this
chapter.

(17) Upon appropriate application, the commissioner
shall issue to a classic motor vehicle or classic motorcycle
as defined in section three-a, article ten of this chapter, a
special registration plate designed by the commissioner.
An annual fee of fifteen dollars, in addition to all other
fees required by this chapter, shall be charged for each
classic registration plate.

402 18) Honorably discharged veterans may be issued special
403 registration plates for motorcycles subject to Class G
404 registration as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, there shall be issued
to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch of the
armed services of the United States a special registration
plate for any number of motorcycles subject to Class G
registration titled in the name of the qualified applicant
with an insignia designed by the commissioner of the
division of motor vehicles.

412 (B) A special initial application fee of ten dollars shall be 413 charged in addition to all other fees required by law. This special fee is to compensate the division of motor vehicles 414 for additional costs and services required in the issuing of 415 416 the special registration and shall be collected by the 417 division and deposited in a special revolving fund to be 418 used for the administration of this section: Provided, That 419 nothing in this section may be construed to exempt any 420 veteran from any other provision of this chapter.

421 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
422 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans license
423 plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does not
424 renew the license plate.

425 (19) Racing theme special registration plates:

426 (A) The division may issue a series of special registration
427 plates displaying national association for stock car auto
428 racing themes;

(B) An annual fee of twenty-five dollars shall be charged
for each special racing theme registration plate in addition
to all other fees required by this chapter. All annual fees
collected for each special racing theme registration plate
shall be deposited into a special revolving fund to be used
in the administration of this chapter;

435 (C) A special application fee of ten dollars shall be
436 charged at the time of initial application as well as upon
437 application for any duplicate or replacement registration
438 plate, in addition to all other fees required by this chapter.
439 All application fees shall be deposited into a special
440 revolving fund to be used in the administration of this
441 chapter.

(20) The division may issue recipients of the navy cross,
distinguished service cross, distinguished flying cross, air
force cross, bronze star or silver star special registration
plates as follows:

(A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall 446 issue to any recipient of the navy cross, distinguished 447 service cross, distinguished flying cross, air force cross, 448 silver star or bronze star, a registration plate for any 449 number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified 450 applicant bearing letters or numbers. A separate registra-451 tion plate shall be designed by the commissioner of motor 452 vehicles for each award that denotes that those individuals 453 who are granted this special registration plate are recipi-454 ents of the navy cross, distinguished service cross, distin-455 guished flying cross, air force cross, silver star or bronze 456 star, as applicable. 457

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees required by
law. This special fee is to compensate the division of

461 motor vehicles for additional costs and services required
462 in the issuing of the special registration and shall be
463 collected by the division and deposited in a special revolv464 ing fund to be used for the administration of this section:
465 *Provided*, That nothing in this section exempts the appli466 cant for a special registration plate under this subdivision
467 from any other provision of this chapter.

(C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
deceased spouse's navy cross, distinguished service cross,
distinguished flying cross, air force cross, silver star or
bronze star special registration plate until the surviving
spouse dies, remarries or does not renew the special
registration plate.

474 (21) The division may issue honorably discharged475 veterans special registration plates as follows:

476 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall 477 issue to any honorably discharged veteran of any branch 478 of the armed services of the United States with verifiable 479 service during World War II, the Korean War, the Vietnam 480 War, the Persian Gulf War or the War against Terrorism, 481 a special registration plate for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the qualified applicant with an 482 insignia designed by the commissioner denoting service in 483 484 the applicable conflict.

(B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 485 486 application fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees 487 required by law. This special fee is to compensate the 488 division of motor vehicles for additional costs and services required in the issuing of the special registration and shall 489 490 be collected by the division and deposited in a special 491 revolving fund to be used for the administration of this section: Provided, That nothing contained in this section 492 493 may be construed to exempt any veteran from any other 494 provision of this chapter.

495 (C) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her
496 deceased spouse's honorably discharged veterans registra497 tion plate until the surviving spouse dies, remarries or does
498 not renew the special registration plate.

499 (22) The division may issue special volunteer firefighter500 registration plates as follows:

501 (A) Any owner of a motor vehicle who is a resident of 502 West Virginia and who is a volunteer fireman or woman 503 may apply for a special license plate for one Class A 504 vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant which 505 bears the insignia of the profession in white letters on a 506 red background. The insignia shall be designed by the 507 commissioner and shall contain a fireman's helmet insig-508 nia on the left side of the license plate.

(B) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivi-509 sion shall be accompanied by an affidavit signed by the 510 applicant's fire chief, stating that the applicant is a 511 volunteer fireman or woman and justified in having a 512 registration plate with the requested insignia. The appli-513 cant must comply with all other laws of this state regard-514 ing registration and licensure of motor vehicles and must 515 pay all required fees. Only one such license plate may be 516 issued to a volunteer fireman or woman. 517

518 (C) Each application submitted pursuant to this subdivi-519 sion shall be accompanied by payment of a special one-520 time initial application fee of one dollar, which is in 521 addition to any other registration or license fee required 522 by this chapter. All application fees shall be deposited into 523 a special revolving fund to be used in the administration 524 of this chapter.

(23) The division may issue special registration plates
which reflect patriotic themes, including the display of any
United States symbol, icon, phrase or expression, which
evokes patriotic pride or recognition.

529 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division shall 530 issue to an applicant a registration plate of the applicant's 531 choice, displaying a patriotic theme as provided in this 532 subdivision, for a vehicle titled in the name of the appli-533 cant. A series of registration plates displaying patriotic 534 themes shall be designed by the commissioner of motor 535 vehicles for distribution to applicants.

536 (B) The division shall charge a special one-time initial 537 application fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees 538 required by law. a special registration plate depicting the symbol of the 4-H

health as well as the symbol of the future farmers of
America organization which represents a cross section of
an ear of corn for any number of vehicles titled in the
name of the qualified applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees required by
law. This special fee is to compensate the division of motor
vehicles for additional costs and services required in the
issuing of the special registration and shall be collected by
the division and deposited in a special revolving fund to be
used for the administration of this section:

577 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of fifteen
578 dollars for each special 4-H future farmers of America
579 registration plate in addition to all other fees required by
580 this chapter.

(26) The division may issue special registration plates to
educators in the state's elementary and secondary schools
and in the state's institutions of higher education as
follows:

585 (A) Upon appropriate application, the division may issue
586 a special registration plate designed by the commissioner
587 for any number of vehicles titled in the name of the
588 qualified applicant.

(B) The division shall charge a special initial application
fee of ten dollars in addition to all other fees required by
law. This special fee is to compensate the division of motor
vehicles for additional costs and services required in the
issuing of the special registration and shall be collected by
the division and deposited in a special revolving fund to be
used for the administration of this section:

596 (C) The division shall charge an annual fee of fifteen
597 dollars for each special educator registration plate in

(d) The commissioner shall propose rules for legislative
approval in accordance with the provisions of article three,

forms to be used in making application for the special
license plates authorized by this section.

(e)(1) Nothing in this section may be construed to require
a charge for a free prisoner of war license plate or a free
recipient of the congressional medal of honor license plate
for a vehicle titled in the name of the qualified applicant

609 (2) A surviving spouse may continue to use his or her

635 (2) An initial nonrefundable feeshall be charged for each

641 (g) The provisions of this section may not be construed to

64.7 (h) The commissioner may, in his or her discretion, issue 648 a registration plate of reflectorized material suitable for 649 permanent use on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers, 650 together with appropriate devices to be attached to the registration to indicate the year for which the vehicles 651 652 have been properly registered or the date of expiration of the registration. The design and expiration of the plates 653 shall be determined by the commissioner. 654

(i) Any license plate issued or renewed pursuant to this
chapter, which is paid for by a check that is returned for
nonsufficient funds, is void without further notice to the
applicant. The applicant may not reinstate the registration until the returned check is paid by the applicant in
cash, money order or certified check and all applicable
fees assessed as a result thereof have been paid.
