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[Passed January 30, 2002; in effect from passage.]

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AN ACT to amend and reenact section seven, article one, chapter twenty-four-e of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to the state-wide addressing and mapping board; and extending deadline for the board to issue requests for proposals and legislative rules.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That section seven, article one, chapter twenty-four-e of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

**ARTICLE 1. WEST VIRGINIA STATEWIDE ADDRESSING AND MAPPING BOARD.**

**§24E-1-7. Request for proposals; title to works; disbursements to vendors and public agencies; legislative and emergency rules.**

1 (a) The board shall, no later than the first day of  
2 January, two thousand three, issue a request or requests  
3 for proposals for statewide addressing and mapping. The  
4 request for proposal must include requirements that each  
5 map, compilation or other work created as a result of the  
6 statewide addressing and mapping intended to be accom-  
7 plished by this article must be a "work made for hire"  
8 within the meaning of the copyright laws of the United  
9 States, 17 U. S. C. §101, *et seq.*, and that all right, title and  
10 interest to each map, compilation or other work must vest  
11 in the board. The request or requests for proposal may  
12 include any standards or requirements the board finds  
13 necessary or proper, including, without limitation, compli-  
14 ance with any applicable emergency or legislative rules.  
15 The board shall select a qualified vendor or vendors in  
16 accordance with the applicable provisions of article three,  
17 chapter five-a of this code. Disbursements from the West  
18 Virginia statewide addressing and mapping fund estab-  
19 lished by section five of this article are specifically autho-  
20 rized in order to pay the selected vendor or vendors.

21 (b) The board may also consider applications of public  
22 agencies, including, without limitation, county commis-  
23 sions and municipalities, to participate in the statewide  
24 addressing and mapping to be accomplished by this  
25 article. Disbursements from the West Virginia statewide  
26 addressing and mapping fund are specifically authorized  
27 in order to reimburse such public agencies, in whole or in  
28 part, for the costs incurred by them in participating in the  
29 addressing and mapping to be accomplished by this article  
30 in the amount, if any, determined by the board.

31 (c) No later than the first day of January, two thousand  
32 three, the board shall propose legislative rules to accom-  
33 plish the purposes of this section in accordance with the  
34 provisions of article three, chapter twenty-nine-a of this

35 code. The rules may require public agencies that apply for  
36 reimbursement under this section, but that are exempt  
37 from statewide standards under section six of this article,  
38 to comply with acceptable standards to be specified in  
39 those rules as a condition of receiving reimbursement. The  
40 standards, however, are not necessarily required to be the  
41 statewide standards to be proposed by the board in  
42 legislative rules under said section. Emergency rules are  
43 specifically authorized for the purposes of this section.
