Senate Bill No. 547

(BY SENATORS BAILEY, ANDERSON, UNGER AND CALDWELL)

[Passed March 8, 2002; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact section seventeen, article one-b, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to providing for a monthly administrative allowance for certain members of rank in the West Virginia national guard.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That section seventeen, article one-b, chapter fifteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 1B. NATIONAL GUARD.

§15-1B-17. Command pay; inspections; compensation for clerical services and care of property.

- 1 (a) There may be paid to each commander of a brigade,
- 2 regiment, air wing, army group or other corresponding
- 3 type organization one hundred dollars per month and to

4 each commander of a battalion, army squadron, air group
5 or other equivalent type organization fifty dollars per
6 month and to each commander of a company, air squadron
7 or other equivalent type organization twenty-five dollars
8 per month, payable quarterly, to be known as command
9 pay.

10 (b) There shall be allowed to each headquarters of a
11 brigade, regiment, air wing, army group or equivalent type
12 organization the sum of one hundred dollars per month
13 and each headquarters of a battalion, army squadron, air
14 group or corresponding type organization the sum of fifty
15 dollars per month for clerical services; and to each com-
16 pany air squadron or corresponding type unit the sum of
17 twenty-five dollars per month for like services, payable
18 quarterly. The commandant of the West Virginia military
19 academy shall be allowed the sum of twenty-five dollars a
20 month, payable quarterly, for like services.

21 (c) At the discretion of the adjutant general, there may
22 be paid to the enlisted man or woman who is directly
23 responsible for the care and custody of the federal and
24 state property of each organization or unit the sum of ten
25 dollars per month, payable quarterly, upon the certificate
26 of his or her commanding officer that he or she has
27 faithfully and satisfactorily performed the duties assigned
28 him or her and accounted for all property entrusted to his
29 or her care.

30 (d) The adjutant general shall determine the amount of
31 entitlement to command pay and clerical pay, not to
32 exceed the amounts set forth in subsections (a) and (b) of
33 this section, using organizational charts showing chain of
34 command and authorized strengths and defining other
35 equivalent type organizations.

36 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of this code,
37 there shall be paid to the command administrative officer
38 of the headquarters of the West Virginia army national
39 guard and to the executive staff support officer of the

40 headquarters of the West Virginia air national guard, or to
41 the officer occupying a similar position, regardless of title,
42 one hundred dollars per month, payable quarterly, to be
43 known as an administrative allowance.

44 (f) The state command sergeant of the West Virginia
45 army national guard and the command chief master
46 sergeant of the West Virginia air national guard shall
47 receive a monthly administrative allowance of one hun-
48 dred dollars per month. The command sergeant major or
49 command chief master sergeant of a unit authorized under
50 the command of a commander in the rank of colonel shall
51 receive a monthly administrative allowance of seventy-five
52 dollars per month. The command sergeant major or
53 command chief master sergeant of a unit authorized under
54 the command of a commander in the rank of lieutenant
55 colonel shall receive a monthly administrative allowance
56 of forty-five dollars per month.
