Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article four, chapter sixty-four of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 4. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION AND THE ARTS TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-4-1. Division of culture and history.

1 The legislative rule filed in the state register on the twenty-2 sixth day of July, two thousand two, authorized under the 3 authority of section four, article one, chapter twenty-nine of this code, modified by the division of culture and history to meet the 4 objections of the legislative rule-making review committee and 5 6 refiled in the state register on the fifth day of December, two 7 thousand two, relating to the division of culture and history 8 (cultural facilities and capital resources grant program, 82 CSR 9 7), is authorized.
