AN ACT to amend and reenact section eight, article ten-1, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, relating to continuation of the personal assistance services program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


That section eight, article ten-1, chapter eighteen of the code of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 10L. RON YOST PERSONAL ASSISTANCE SERVICES ACT.

§18-10L-8. Continuation of program.

1 The personal assistance services program shall continue to
2 exist, pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of
3 this code, until the first day of July, two thousand six, unless
4 sooner terminated, continued or reestablished pursuant to the
5 provisions of that article.




