AN ACT to repeal §11B-2-18 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to expenditure of excess in collections upon approval of governor.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. STATE BUDGET OFFICE.

§1. Repeal of section relating to expenditure of excess in collections; notices to auditor and treasurer.

1 Section eighteen, article two, chapter eleven-b of the code
2 of West Virginia, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, as
3 amended, is hereby repealed.






