AN ACT to amend §5-14-4 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to correcting the statutory inconsistency of appointments to the commission for the deaf and hard-of-hearing in relation to the terms and number of appointees.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §5-14-4 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 14. WEST VIRGINIA COMMISSION FOR THE DEAF AND HARD-OF-HEARING.

§5-14-4. Terms of office; quorum.

- 1 Members of the commission who do not serve ex officio
- 2 shall be appointed for the following terms: Three members
- 3 shall be appointed for a term of three years; three for a
- 4 term of two years; and three for a term of one year. When
- 5 a vacancy occurs, an appointment shall be made for the
- 6 unexpired term. The members shall annually elect a

- 7 chairman. A majority of the members constitutes a
- 8 quorum for the transaction of business.
