# Senate Bill No. 516

(SENATORS UNGER, SNYDER AND ROWE, original sponsors)

[Passed March 13, 2004; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to establish the West Virginia eastern panhandle transportation authority to include representatives from Berkeley, Jefferson and Morgan counties; appointment of officers; and powers of authority.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

#### WEST VIRGINIA EASTERNPANHANDLE TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY.

- §1. West Virginia eastern panhandle transportation authority created; purposes.
  - 1 There is hereby created a West Virginia eastern panhan-
  - 2 dle transportation authority to promote and advance the
  - 3 construction of a modern highway through Berkeley,
  - 4 Jefferson and Morgan counties and to coordinate with
  - 5 counties, municipalities, state and federal agencies, public
  - 6 nonprofit corporations, private corporations, associations,

- 7 partnerships and individuals for the purpose of planning.
- 8 assisting and establishing recreational, tourism, industrial,
- 9 economic and community development of West Virginia
- 10 Route 9 and the new Route 9 proposals and construction
- 11 from the Virginia line to Berkeley Springs, Interstate 81,
- 12 Route 11, Route 522, Route 340 and also any existing and
- 13 proposed by-passes around any municipalities, as well as
- 14 any other highways in those counties for the benefit of
- 15 West Virginians.

### §2. Members; appointment; officers.

- 1 (a) The authority consists of nine voting members and
- 2 three ex officio nonvoting members. All members shall be
- 3 appointed before the first day of July, two thousand four.
- 4 (b) Each of the county commissions of the counties of
- 5 Berkeley, Jefferson, and Morgan shall appoint three voting
- 6 members to the authority. The terms of the voting mem-
- 7 bers initially appointed by a county commission are as
- 8 follows: One member shall be appointed for a term of two
- 9 years and two members shall be appointed for terms of
- 10 four years. All successive appointments shall be for four-
- 11 year terms. Any voting member may be removed for cause
- 12 by the appointing county commission.
- 13 (c) The three ex officio nonvoting members are the
- 14 commissioner of highways or his or her designee, the
- 15 director of the parkways, economic development and
- 16 tourism authority or his or her designee and the executive
- 17 director of the West Virginia development office or his or
- 18 her designee.
- 19 (d) Should a vacancy occur, the person appointed to fill
- 20 the vacancy shall serve only for the unexpired portion
- 21 thereof. All members are eligible for reappointment.
- 22 (e) The authority shall meet annually on the third
- 23 Monday in July and at such other times designated by the
- 24 authority in its bylaws. A special meeting may be called
- 25 by the president, the secretary or any two members of the

- 26 authority and may be held only after all members are
- 27 given notice of the meeting in writing. Five voting mem-
- 28 bers constitute a quorum for all meetings. At each annual
- 29 meeting of the authority, it shall elect a president, vice
- 30 president, secretary and treasurer. The authority shall
- 31 adopt bylaws and rules as may be necessary for its opera-
- 32 tion and management.

### §3. Powers.

- 1 (a) The authority has all but only those powers necessary,
- 2 incidental, convenient and advisable for the following
- 3 purposes:
- 4 (1) Promoting economic development and tourism along
- West Virginia Route 9 and the new Route 9 proposals and
- 6 construction from the Virginia line to Berkeley Springs,
- 7 Interstate 81, Route 11, Route 522, Route 340 and also any
- 8 existing and proposed by-passes around any municipali-
- 9 ties, as well as any other highways in Berkeley, Jefferson
- 10 and Morgan counties;
- 11 (2) Advocating actions consistent with that plan or its
- 12 provisions to or before any governmental entity or any
- 13 private person or entity; and
- 14 (3) Otherwise acting in an advisory capacity with regard
- 15 to any aspects of West Virginia Route 9 and new Route 9
- 16 construction and design and other highways in those
- 17 counties at the request of or without the request of any
- 18 governmental entity or private person or entity.
- 19 (b) The authority may not own any of the real estate or
- 20 real property herein described for development and may
- 21 not be responsible for operating or maintaining the
- 22 highways described herein.
