AN ACT to amend and reenact §31-16-5 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuation of the steel advisory commission and steel futures program.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §31-16-5 of the code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 16. WEST VIRGINIA STEEL FUTURES PROGRAM.

§31-16-5. Continuation of commission and program.

- 1 The steel advisory commission and the steel futures
- 2 program shall continue to exist until the first day of July,
- 3 two thousand five, unless sooner terminated, continued or
- 4 reestablished pursuant to the provisions of article ten,
- 5 chapter four of this code.
