## **Senate Bill No. 285**

(BY SENATORS BOWMAN, BAILEY, CHAFIN, JENKINS, KESSLER,  
McCABE, MINARD, BOLEY, HARRISON, MINEAR AND WEEKS)

[Passed April 9, 2005; to take effect July 1, 2005.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact §29-1-1b of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to continuation of the Division of Culture and History.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:*

That §29-1-1b of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

### **ARTICLE 1. DIVISION OF CULTURE AND HISTORY.**

#### **§29-1-1b. Continuation of the Division of Culture and History.**

1 Pursuant to the provisions of article ten, chapter four of  
2 this code, the Division of Culture and History shall  
3 continue to exist until the first day of July, two thousand  
4 seven, unless sooner terminated, continued or reestab-  
5 lished.
