AN ACT to amend and reenact article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating generally to the promulgation of administrative rules by the various executive or administrative agencies and the procedures relating thereto; legislative mandate or authorization for the promulgation of certain legislative rules by various executive or administrative agencies of the state; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules in the form that the rules were filed in the State Register; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules with various modifications presented to and recommended by the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee; authorizing certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules as amended by the Legislature; authorizing Enr. Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 341] 2

certain of the agencies to promulgate certain legislative rules with various modifications presented to and recommended by the Legislative Rule-Making Review Committee and as amended by the Legislature: authorizing Health Care promulgate a legislative rule relating to Authority to benchmarking and discount contracts: authorizing Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to implementation of Omnibus Health Care Act; authorizing Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to implementation of Omnibus Health Care Act payment provisions; authorizing Department of Health and Human Resources and Insurance Commissioner to promulgate a legislative rule relating to uniform credentialing of health care practitioners; authorizing Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to methods and standards for chemical test for intoxication: and authorizing Department of Health and Human Resources to promulgate a legislative rule relating to Grade "A" pasturized milk.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That article 5, chapter 64 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 5. AUTHORIZATION FOR DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN RESOURCES TO PROMULGATE LEGISLATIVE RULES.

§64-5-1. Health Care Authority.
