AN ACT to amend and reenact §11A-3-2 and §11A-3-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to requiring payments for delinquent real estate taxes submitted within fourteen days prior to the date of the sheriff's sale be made by cashier's check, money order, certified check or United States currency.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §11A-3-2 and §11A-3-4 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. SALE OF TAX LIENS AND NONENTERED, ESCHEATED AND WASTE AND UNAPPROPRIATED LANDS.

§11A-3-2. Second publication of list of delinquent real estate; notice.

1 (a) On or before the tenth day of September of each year, 2 the sheriff shall prepare a second list of delinquent lands, which 3 shall include all real estate in his or her county remaining 4 delinquent as of the first day of September, together with a 5 notice of sale, in form or effect as follows:

6 Notice is hereby given that tax liens for the following described tracts or lots of land or undivided interests therein in 7 the County of _____ which are delinquent for the 8 9 nonpayment of taxes for the year (or years) 20____, will be offered for sale by the undersigned sheriff (or collector) at 10 11 public auction at the front door of the courthouse of the county, 12 between the hours of nine in the morning and four in the afternoon, on the _____, 20____. 13

Tax liens on each unredeemed tract or lot, or each unredeemed part thereof or undivided interest therein, will be sold at public auction to the highest bidder in an amount which shall not be less than the taxes, interest and charges which shall be due thereon to the date of sale, as set forth in the following table:

Any of the aforesaid tracts or lots, or part thereof or an undivided interest therein, may be redeemed by the payment to the undersigned sheriff (or collector) before sale, of the total amount of taxes, interest and charges due thereon up to the date of redemption. Payments received within fourteen business days prior to the date of sale must be paid by cashier check, money order, certified check or United States currency.

The sheriff shall publish the list and notice prior to the sale date fixed in the notice as a Class III-0 legal advertisement in compliance with the provisions of article three, chapter fifty-nine of this code, and the publication area for such publication shall be the county.

(b) In addition to such publication, no less than thirty days prior to the sale the sheriff shall send a notice of the delinquency and the date of sale by certified mail: (1) To the last known address of each person listed in the land books whose taxes are delinquent; (2) to each person having a lien on real property upon which the taxes are due as disclosed by a statement filed with the sheriff pursuant to the provisions of section three of this article; (3) to each other person with an interest in the property or with a fiduciary relationship to a person with an interest in the property who has in writing delivered to the sheriff on a form prescribed by the Tax Commissioner a request for such notice of delinquency; and (4) in the case of property which includes a mineral interest but does not include an interest in the surface other than an interest for the purpose of developing the minerals, to each person who has in writing delivered to the sheriff, on a form prescribed by the Tax Commissioner, a request for such notice which identifies the person as an owner of an interest in the surface of real property that is included in the boundaries of such property: Provided, That in a case where one owner owns more than one parcel of real property upon which taxes are delinquent, the sheriff may, at his option, mail separate notices to the owner and each lienholder for each parcel or may prepare and mail to the owner and each lienholder a single notice which pertains to

- all such delinquent parcels. If the sheriff elects to mail only one notice, that notice shall set forth a legally sufficient description of all parcels of property on which taxes are delinquent. In no event shall failure to receive the mailed notice by the landowner
- 66 event shall failure to receive the mailed notice by the landowner 67 or lienholder affect the validity of the title of the property
- 68 conveyed if it is conveyed pursuant to section twenty-seven or
- 69 fifty-nine of this article.
- (c) (1) To cover the cost of preparing and publishing the second delinquent list, a charge of twelve dollars and fifty cents shall be added to the taxes, interest and charges already due on each item and all such charges shall be stated in the list as a part of the total amount due.
- 175 (2) To cover the cost of preparing and mailing notice to the landowner, lienholder or any other person entitled thereto pursuant to this section, a charge of five dollars per addressee shall be added to the taxes, interest and charges already due on each item and all such charges shall be stated in the list as a part of the total amount due.
- 81 (d) Any person whose taxes were delinquent on the first day 82 of September may have his or her name removed from the 83 delinquent list prior to the time the same is delivered to the 84 newspapers for publication by paying to the sheriff the full 85 amount of taxes and costs owed by the person at the date of 86 such redemption. In such case, the sheriff shall include but three 87 dollars of the costs provided in this section in making such 88 redemption. Costs collected by the sheriff hereunder which are 89 not expended for publication and mailing shall be paid into the 90 general county fund.

§11A-3-4. Redemption after second publication and before sale.

- 1 Any of the real estate included in the list published pursuant
- 2 to the provisions of section two of this article may be redeemed
- 3 at any time before sale as provided in section eighteen, article
- 4 two of this chapter. All payments for delinquent real estate

- 5 taxes received within fourteen business days prior to the date of
- 6 sale must be paid by cashier check, money order, certified
- 7 check or United States currency.
