AN ACT to amend and reenact §8A-11-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to factory-built homes; updating compliance documentation for evidence in a court case; clarifying regulation by local governments; and requiring construction and installation to comply with federal regulations and applicable law.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §8A-11-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 11. SPECIAL PROVISIONS.

§8A-11-1. Standards for factory-built homes.

1 (a) Notwithstanding any existing provisions of law, 2 municipal or county ordinance or state building code, the 3 standards for factory-built homes, housing prototypes, 4 subsystems, materials and components certified as acceptable by the federal Department of Housing and Urban 5 Development are considered acceptable and are approved 6 7 for use in housing construction in this state. 8 (b) Appropriate building code compliance documenta-9 tion attached to a factory-built home shall constitute prima facie evidence that the products or materials 10 11 contained therein are acceptable. 12 (c) A governing body of a municipality or a county, when 13 enacting residential design standards for the purposes of 14 regulating the subdivision, development and use of land, 15 shall uniformly apply such design standards and associated review and permitting procedures for factory-built 16 and other single-family constructed homes. 17 18 (d) Factory-built homes, like other types of homes, shall 19 be constructed and installed in conformity with the

20 requirements of 44 C. F. R. §60.3(1976) and any applica-

21 ble statute or rule relating to building in a flood zone.
