AN ACT to amend the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, by adding thereto a new section, designated §24A-6-7, relating to providing that indemnity agreements in motor carrier transportation contracts are void and unenforceable as against public policy; and effective date.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended by adding thereto a new section, designated §24A-6-7, to read as follows:

ARTICLE 6. DUTIES AND PRIVILEGES OF MOTOR CARRIERS SUBJECT TO REGULATION OF THE COMMISSION.

### §24A-6-7. Indemnity agreement in motor carrier transportation contracts void.

- 1 (a) Notwithstanding any provision of law to the con-
- 2 trary, a provision, clause, covenant or agreement contained
- 3 in, collateral to or affecting a motor carrier transportation
- 4 contract entered into on or after the first day of July, two
- 5 thousand six, that purports to indemnify, defend or hold
- 6 harmless, or has the effect of indemnifying, defending or
- 7 holding harmless, the promisee from or against any
- 8 liability for loss or damage resulting from the negligence
- 9 or intentional acts or omissions of the promisee is against
- 10 the public policy of this state and is void and unenforce-
- 11 able.
- 12 (b) In this section:
- 13 (1) "Motor carrier transportation contract" means a
- 14 contract, agreement or understanding covering:
- 15 (A) The transportation of property for compensation or
- 16 hire by the motor carrier;
- 17 (B) Entrance on property by the motor carrier for the
- 18 purpose of loading, unloading or transporting property for
- 19 compensation or hire; or
- 20 (C) A service incidental to activity described in para-
- 21 graph (A) or (B), including, but not limited to, storage of
- 22 property.
- 23 (2) "Promisee" means the promisee and any agents,
- 24 employees, servants or independent contractors who are
- 25 directly responsible to the promisee except for motor
- 26 carriers party to a motor carrier transportation contract
- 27 with promisee and such motor carrier's agents, employees,
- 28 servants or independent contractors directly responsible to
- 29 such motor carrier.
- 30 (3) The term "motor carrier transportation contract"
- 31 shall not include the Uniform Intermodal Interchange and
- 32 Facilities Access Agreement administered by the
