## Senate Bill No. 603

(SENATORS CARUTH, MCKENZIE, DEEM, HARRISON, YODER, MINEAR AND MCCABE, original sponsors)

[Passed March 11, 2006; in effect ninety days from passage.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact §2-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to renaming the day after Thanksgiving Day as Lincoln's Day.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §2-2-1 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. LEGAL HOLIDAYS; SPECIAL MEMORIAL DAYS; CONSTRUC-TION OF STATUTES; DEFINITIONS.

§2-2-1. Legal holidays; official acts or court proceedings.

- 1 (a) The following days are legal holidays:
- 2 (1) The first day of January is "New Year's Day";

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3 (2) The third Monday of January is "Martin Luther4 King's Birthday";

5 (3) The third Monday of February is "Presidents' Day";

6 (4) The last Monday in May is "Memorial Day";

7 (5) The twentieth day of June is "West Virginia Day";

8 (6) The fourth day of July is "Independence Day";

9 (7) The first Monday of September is "Labor Day";

10 (8) The second Monday of October is "Columbus Day";

11 (9) The eleventh day of November is "Veterans' Day";

12 (10) The fourth Thursday of November is "Thanksgiving13 Day";

14 (11) The day after Thanksgiving Day is "Lincoln's Day";

15 (12) The twenty-fifth day of December is "Christmas16 Day";

(13) Any day on which a general, primary or special
election is held is a holiday throughout the state, a political subdivision of the state, a district or an incorporated
city, town or village in which the election is conducted;

(14) General election day on even years shall be designated
nated Susan B Anthony Day, in accordance with the
provisions of subsection (b), section one-a of this article;
and

(15) Any day proclaimed or ordered by the Governor or
the President of the United States as a day of special
observance or Thanksgiving, or a day for the general
cessation of business, is a holiday.

(b) If a holiday otherwise described in subsection (a) of
this section falls on a Sunday, then the following Monday
is the legal holiday. If a holiday otherwise described in
subsection (a) of this section falls on a Saturday, then the

33 preceding Friday is the legal holiday: *Provided*, That this

34 subsection (b) shall not apply to subdivisions (13), (14) and

35 (15), subsection (a) of this section.

36 (c) Any day or part thereof designated by the Governor 37 as time off, without charge against accrued annual leave, for state employees statewide may also be time off for 38 39 county employees if the county commission elects to 40 designate the day or part thereof as time off, without 41 charge against accrued annual leave for county employees. 42 Any entire or part statewide day off designated by the Governor may, for all courts, be treated as if it were a legal 43 44 holiday.

45 (d) In computing any period of time prescribed by any 46 applicable provision of this code or any legislative rule or other administrative rule or regulation promulgated 47 pursuant to the provisions of this code, the day of the act, 48 event, default or omission from which the applicable 49 50 period begins to run is not included. The last day of the 51 period so computed is included, unless it is a Saturday, a 52 Sunday, a legal holiday or a designated day off in which event the prescribed period of time runs until the end of 53 the next day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday 54 55 or designated day off.

56 (e) If any applicable provision of this code or any legislative rule or other administrative rule or regulation 57 58 promulgated pursuant to the provisions of this code designates a particular date on, before or after which an 59 60 act, event, default or omission is required or allowed to 61 occur, and if the particular date designated falls on a 62 Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday or designated day off, then the date on which the act, event, default or omission 63 64 is required or allowed to occur is the next day that is not 65 a Saturday, Sunday, legal holiday or designated day off.

(f) With regard to the courts of this state, the computation of periods of time, the specific dates or days when an
act, event, default or omission is required or allowed to

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69 occur and the relationship of those time periods and dates

70 to Saturdays, Sundays, legal holidays, or days designated

71 as weather or other emergency days pursuant to section

72 two of this article are governed by rules promulgated by

- 73 the Supreme Court of Appeals.
- 74 (g) The provisions of this section do not increase or
- 75 diminish the legal school holidays provided in section two,
- 76 article five, chapter eighteen-a of this code.
