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Senate Bill No. 636

(BY SENATOR BAILEY)

[Passed March 9, 2006; to take effect July 1, 2006.]

AN ACT to amend and reenact §51-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to the Court Security Fund and administrative costs therein; and authorizing a fee of three percent not to exceed thirty-thousand dollars to Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety for administering Court Security Fund.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §51-3-14 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 3. COURTS IN GENERAL.

§51-3-14. Court security fund.

- 1 (a) The offices and the clerks of the magistrate courts
- 2 and the circuit courts shall, on or before the tenth day of
- 3 each month, transmit all fees and costs received for the
- 4 Court Security Fund in accordance with the provisions of
- 5 sections one and two, article three, chapter fifty of this

6 code and section eleven, article one, chapter fifty-nine of
7 this code for deposit in the State Treasury to the credit of
8 a special revenue fund to be known as the Court Security
9 Fund, which is hereby created under the Department of
10 Military Affairs and Public Safety. The Court Security
11 Fund may receive any gifts, grants, contributions or other
12 money from any source which is specifically designated for
13 deposit in the fund. All moneys collected and received and
14 paid into the State Treasury and credited to the Court
15 Security Fund shall be expended by the board exclusively
16 to implement the improvement measures agreed upon in
17 accordance with the security plans submitted pursuant to
18 section sixteen of this article and in accordance with an
19 appropriation by the Legislature and to pay expenses of
20 the Department of Military Affairs and Public Safety in
21 administering this fund, which expenses may not in any
22 fiscal year exceed the lesser of three percent of the funds
23 deposited into the court security fund or thirty thousand
24 dollars. Amounts collected which are found from time to
25 time to exceed the funds needed for the purposes set forth
26 in this article may be transferred to other accounts or
27 funds and redesignated for other purposes upon appropri-
28 ation by the Legislature.

29 (b) Notwithstanding any provision of this code to the
30 contrary, after the thirtieth day of June, two thousand, the
31 court security board shall transfer such amounts from the
32 Court Security Fund as may, from time to time, be directed
33 by the Legislature in an appropriation act to the Domestic
34 Violence Legal Services Fund created in section four-c,
35 article two-c, chapter forty-eight of this code. Any moneys
36 transferred to the Domestic Violence Legal Services Fund
37 pursuant to the provisions of this section shall be ex-
38 pended for the purposes specified in said section.
