AN ACT to authorize the governing body of the city of Bluefield to appoint two additional nonresident members to the Bluefield Sanitary Board.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

BLUEFIELD SANITARY BOARD.

§1. Legislative findings.

Enr. Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 579] 2

- 1 (a) The Legislature finds that:
- 2 (1) The city of Bluefield is in a unique situation in that
 3 the state line separates the city from the town of
- 4 Bluefield, Virginia;
- 5 (2) The sanitary sewer system serves both the city of
 6 Bluefield, West Virginia, and the town of Bluefield,
 7 Virginia;
- 8 (3) Part of the sanitary sewer system serving the city
 9 of Bluefield, West Virginia, and the town of Bluefield,
 10 Virginia, is located in the town of Bluefield, Virginia;
- (4) The sanitary board that supervises and controlsthe sanitary sewer system serving the city of Bluefield,
- 13 West Virginia, and the town of Bluefield, Virginia, was 14 organized by the city of Bluefield, West Virginia, and 15 the two appointed board members are residents of the 16 city of Bluefield, West Virginia; and
- 16 city of Bluefield, West Virginia; and
- 17 (5) Residents of the town of Bluefield, Virginia, have
 18 no representation in the decisions concerning the
 19 sanitary sewer system affecting their town.
- (b) Therefore, the Legislature declares that since the
 city of Bluefield is in a unique situation, it is in the
 public interest that the governing body of the city of
 Bluefield, West Virginia, be authorized to confirm and
 appoint two additional nonresident members from the
 town of Bluefield, Virginia, to the Bluefield Sanitary
 Board.

§2. Authorizing appointment of nonresident board members.

3 [Enr. Com. Sub. for S. B. No. 579

(a) The governing body of the town of Bluefield, 1 Virginia, is authorized to nominate two additional 2 3 nonresident members to the city of Bluefield Sanitary 4 Board. 5 (b) The two additional nonresident members shall be 6 residents of the town of Bluefield, Virginia. 7 (c) Upon the governing body of the city of Bluefield 8 confirming the nominations, the two additional nonresident members shall serve in accordance with 9 section eighteen, article three, chapter sixteen of the thirteen 10 Code of West Virginia. 11 12 (d) Upon the appointment and confirmation of the said two additional nonresident members, the Bluefield 13 14 Sanitary Board shall be comprised of the following: 15 (1) Two residents of the city of Bluefield, West 16 Virginia; 17 (2) Two residents of the town of Bluefield, Virginia; 18 and 19 (3) The mayor or city manager of the city of Bluefield,
