AN ACT to amend and reenact §20-2-21 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to *Castor canadensis*, or beaver, trapping and tagging of pelts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §20-2-21 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-21. Reporting *Castor canadensis* (beaver); pelts taken and tagged.

1 Each trapper shall present each *Castor canadensis*
2 (beaver) or its pelt to a game checking station or represen-
3 tative of the division within thirty days after the close of
4 a legal season. A tag provided by the division shall be

5 affixed to each *Castor canadensis* pelt and remain at-
6 tached to the pelt until it is processed into commercial fur.
