AN ACT to amend and reenact §1-2-2b and §1-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, all relating to the composition of congressional districts; providing for congressional districts; and requiring incidental precinct boundary changes.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

That §1-2-2b and §1-2-3 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted, all to read as follows:

ARTICLE 2. APPORTIONMENT OF REPRESENTATION.

§1-2-2b. Precinct boundary changes.

1 If an election precinct of this state includes territory
2 contained in more than one senatorial or delegate district, as
3 such senatorial districts are established by section one of this
4 article and as such delegate districts are established by
5 section two of this article, the county commission of the
6 county in which the precinct is located shall, prior to
7 January 21, 2012, alter the boundary lines of its election
8 precincts so that no precinct contains territory included in
9 more than one senatorial or delegate district.

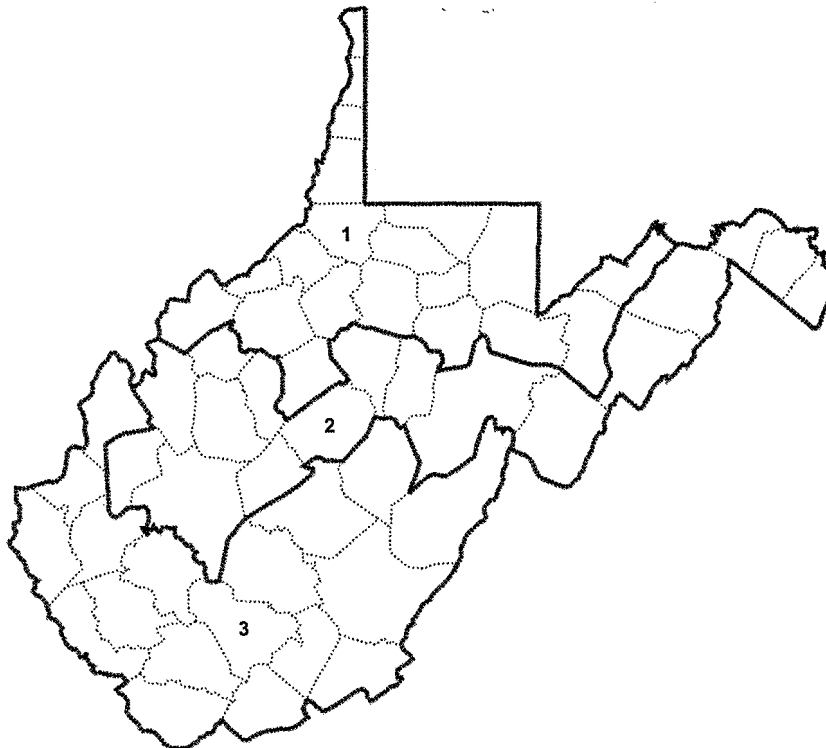
§1-2-3. Congressional districts.

1 The number of members to which the state is entitled in
2 the House of Representatives of the Congress of the United
3 States are apportioned among the counties of the state,
4 arranged into three congressional districts, numbered as
5 follows:

6 First District: Barbour, Brooke, Doddridge, Gilmer, Grant,
7 Hancock, Harrison, Marion, Marshall, Mineral, Monongalia,
8 Ohio, Pleasants, Preston, Ritchie, Taylor, Tucker, Tyler,
9 Wetzel and Wood.

10 Second District: Berkeley, Braxton, Calhoun, Clay,
11 Hampshire, Hardy, Jackson, Jefferson, Kanawha, Lewis,
12 Morgan, Pendleton, Putnam, Randolph, Roane, Upshur and
13 Wirt.

14 Third District: Boone, Cabell, Fayette, Greenbrier, Lincoln,
15 Logan, Mason, McDowell, Mercer, Mingo, Monroe, Nicholas,
16 Pocahontas, Raleigh, Summers, Wayne, Webster and Wyo-
17 ming.
