1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §5-1-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to the designation of daylight saving time.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:


1 That §5-1-25 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, be amended and reenacted
2 to read as follows:


ARTICLE 1. THE GOVERNOR.

§5-1-25. Designation of daylight saving time as official time.

1 Daylight saving time shall be the statewide official time, commencing at two o'clock
2 antemeridian on the second Sunday of March and terminating at two o'clock antemeridian on the
3 first Sunday of November; this time shall apply to all public schools, institutions of higher learning,
4 agencies, departments and political subdivisions of the state.






