1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §20-2-19 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to marking traps with a Division of Natural Resources identification number.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

ARTICLE 2. WILDLIFE RESOURCES.

§20-2-19. Marking of traps.

1 All traps used for taking game or fur-bearing animals shall be marked with a durable plate
2 or tag, attached to the snare, trap, or trap chain, bearing either the name and address of the owner
3 of the trap or the Division of Natural Resources identification number of the owner of the trap.
