1 AN ACT to amend and reenact §60A-9-2 of the Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating
2 to exempting a veterinarian from the requirements of controlled substance monitoring.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of West Virginia:

§60A-9-2. Establishment of program; purpose.

1 There is continued a West Virginia controlled substances monitoring act the purpose of
2 which is to require the recordation and retention in a single repository of information regarding the
3 prescribing, dispensing and consumption of certain controlled substances. A veterinarian is
4 exempt from the requirements of this article.
