1 AN ACT to repeal §16-3-7, §16-3-8, §16-3-9, §16-3-10, §16-3-11, §16-3-12, and §16-3-13 of the
2 Code of West Virginia, 1931, as amended, relating to inflammation of the eyes of
3 newborns.

DISEASES.**

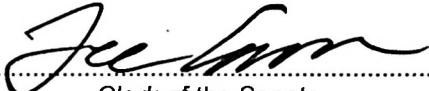
